New Korean Patent Full-Text Database KRFULL released

The new patent full-text database KRFULL for patent applications, granted patents, and utility models published by the Korean Intellectual Property Office has been released. Full-text in machine-translated English is available for the complete file.

KRFULL contains documents from 1978 to the present with more than 4.5 million national family records, more than 6.3 million publications, and more than 3.8 million front page images. Detailed description and claims in English are available since the first publication year 1978. Additionally, the records are available for display in Korean.

Features include numeric property search to enable numeric search in physical and chemical properties, key terms to support efficient full-text searching and results evaluation, standardized and normalized patent assignee names, CPC combination sets, and an additional update date for the full-text only. Bibliographic information has been augmented with related application information, and original patent, application and priority numbers.

More details are available with HELP CON, HELP KEY, HELP NPS, HELP CPC, HELP PAN in the database.

Derwent World Patents Index: Manual Code revision 2020

From DWPI update 2020001 onwards the DWPI Manual Codes is being indexed with the revised 2020 set of codes. The Manual Codes are revised at the start of each year to include new codes suggested by customers as well as the patent analysts at Derwent. For the 2020 revision, 59 new Manual Codes have been added, with 39 new CPI (Chemical Patents Index) codes and 20 new codes in the GMPI/EPI (General and Mechanical Patents Index and Electrical Engineering Patents Index) areas. The new codes allow newly emerging technologies to be indexed in DWPI.

Significant revisions for 2020 include:

- New drug administration codes e.g. Intracardiac (B12-M12Y)
- New drug nano-formulation codes e.g. Nanoparticle (B12-M11Q1)
- New code S05-G02G5 for Pharmacovigilance systems
- New code X21-W for General by-wire / (semi)autonomous vehicle control
- New code X25-A08M8 - 4D compatible materials (4D printing)

As the total number of DWPI updates per year will move to 104 from 2020 onwards, the numbering format for fields /DW (DWPI Update, formerly known as Derwent Week), and /DUPD (DWPI Update, first and latest) had to be adjusted. From the first update of DWPI in 2020, the format increased in length from 6-digits (YYYYWW) to 7-digits (YYYYWWW), where Y represents the year and W the update number. The first 2020 update has DWPI Update 2020001, and can be searched with e.g. 2020001/DW. Pre-2020 updates in DWPI remain unchanged in their original 6-digit format.

New legal event data from Croatia, Italy, and Poland in INPADOCDB and INPAFAMDB

Legal events from Croatia (country code HR) are available for the first time via the INPADOC worldwide legal event data. The Croatian Patent Office will now deliver the data a regular basis.

Data available includes information on the discontinuation of applications, on the grant and discontinuation of IP rights, party data changes and the payment of maintenance fees. Data covered goes back to 1994 and will be uploaded on bi-weekly basis. SPC data is not covered yet, but the EPO is working on the exchange of the SPC data for Croatia soon. 55 legal event codes from Croatia are available for the time being.

SPC legal event data from Italy

From week 04/2020 onwards, information is available in EP documents on the request for and the grant of supplementary protection certificates (SPCs) in Italy (country code IT). Data already loaded ranges from 2015 to 2019. The data will be updated on a regular basis (every time the Italian Patent Office publishes the SPC Bulletin).

Addition of Polish Translation of EP documents

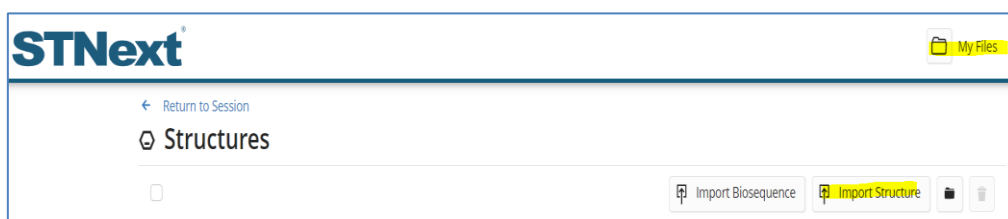
Since entry date 20191128 over 57,000 documents from Poland with Polish translations of EP documents (kind code PLT3) have been added to INPADOC. These documents have publication dates from 2006 onwards. With this addition over 93,000 documents with kind code PLT3 are now available in INPADOC.
